

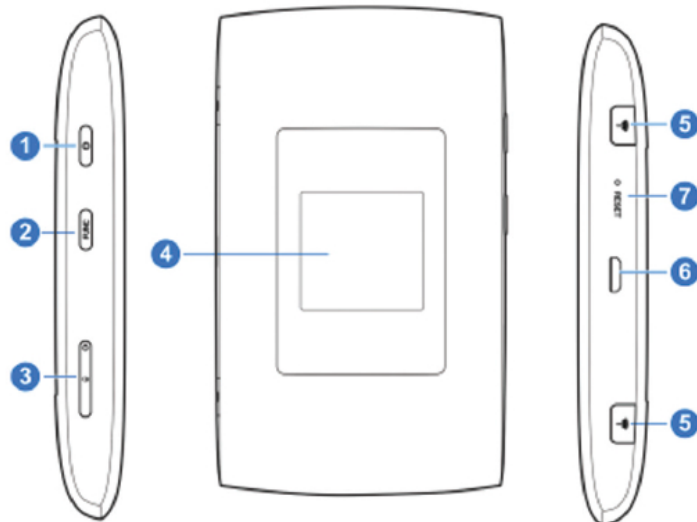
Get to know your hotspot

What's in the box

1. ZTE Warp Connect Mobile Hotspot
2. Quick Start Guide (This Guide)
3. AC Adapter
4. USB Cable
5. Important Information Booklet

Appearance

The following figure is for your reference only.

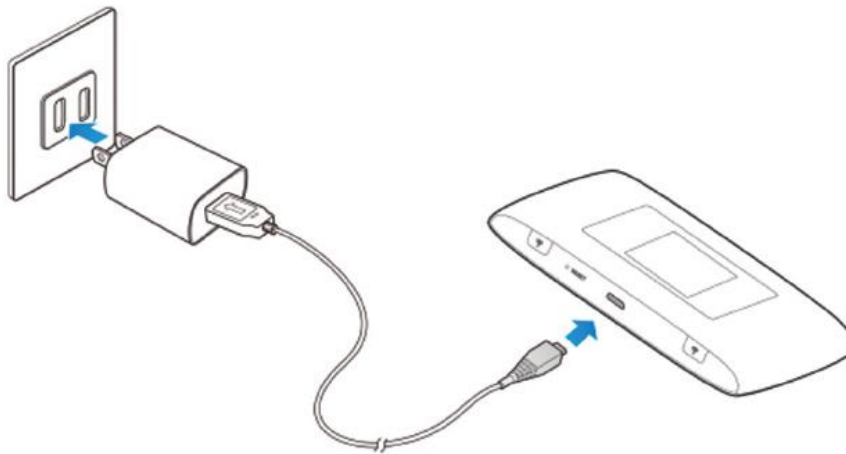


1. Power key
2. Function (FUNC) key
Note: When the screen is off, press the FUNC key to turn on the screen. When the screen is on, press the FUNC key to access the options menu.
3. nano-SIM card slot
4. LCD screen
5. External antenna interface
6. Charger/micro-USB port
7. Reset button (internal)

Before you start

Charge the battery

1. Insert the USB cable into the charging adapter.
2. Insert the small end of the USB cable into the charger/USB port at the bottom of the device.
3. Plug the charging adapter into a standard AC power outlet.



Get ready

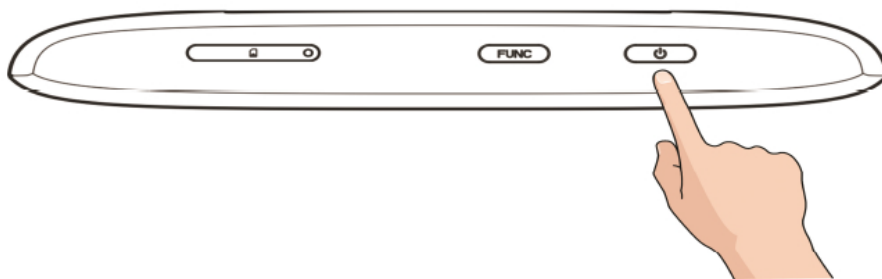
1. Make sure you are in an area covered by the Sprint Mobile network (not roaming).
2. Make sure the device you are trying to connect to your ZTE Warp Connect has its Wi-Fi (wireless network connection) mode turned on.
3. Make sure your ZTE Warp Connect is set up on your Sprint account. (Sign on to your account at sprint.com/mysprint to verify.)

Power up your hotspot

Press and hold the Power key on top of the device to turn it on.






- The device will automatically activate.

Note: It can take several minutes for your device to connect with the Sprint network.



Indicator

When the hotspot is powered on, the following icons may be displayed on the LCD screen.

Icon	Description
	Network signal strength
LTE	Network type
	Roaming status.
	Connected to the Internet
	Wi-Fi status and the number of connected users
	Battery level

Connect to your hotspot

1. Turn on your ZTE Warp Connect and your Wi-Fi enabled device.
2. Open the Wi-Fi application or controls on the computer or Wi-Fi enabled device that you want to connect to your ZTE Warp Connect and find the Wi-Fi name 'SprintHotspot_xxx'.
3. When prompted, enter your Wi-Fi password.
4. Your Wi-Fi enabled device is now connected to the Internet.

Note: You can view the label on the device to get the default Wi-Fi SSID (name) and password.
